OVER 191 PEOPLE WERE INVOLVED IN BOSTONSERVE FROM 27 COMMUNITY GROUPS - AND READ THIS STORY!



On October 24, we were honored to partner with Greater Things for Greater Boston to coordinate BostonServe.

One of the projects was North River Community Church and People's Baptist Church repairing windows and window shades throughout the Timilty School building (see photo at right.) Nonfunctioning window shades were the teachers' biggest frustration and made some teachers on the lower level of the school feel unsafe after hours.

About a month later, there was a shooting in a local park next to the school, forcing a lock-down at school for most of the day. Pastor Paul wrote, "The report we received was that without functioning window shades they would not have been able to comply with these basic safety measures. When I heard that report, I knew right then that the Lord had directly sent us to fix those windows and shades to allow those teachers and students to have a measure of safety and protection in the midst of a tense situation."
